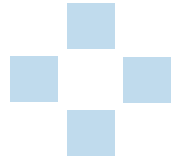

PERMITTING PROCESS AND APPROACH

MPS begins each project with a field survey to verify existing conditions along the access roads, transmission or distribution lines, substations, and rights of way. Our team will investigate ways to avoid permitting, such as using off-line access and utilizing existing road and stream crossings where possible. When conducting field surveys, we document existing conditions of the facilities and any areas that need special attention, such as rights of way, stream crossings, wetland areas, and floodplain/floodway areas. MPS will compile an inventory of environmentally sensitive areas.

We prepare all drawings and documentation for the permitting packages. MPS completes and assembles all permitting applications and works closely with county and state reviewing agencies.
